Involved in a motor vehicle collision?

There is a change in the property damage reporting threshold effective January 1, 2011 in Alberta.

The amount of total property damage in a collision to be reported to a peace officer goes from \$1,000 to \$2,000.

This change is due to the increasing cost of vehicle repairs over the years. The new threshold will better reflect the current situation.

Collision reporting thresholds are set in co-operation with all Canadian jurisdictions through the Canadian Council of Motor Transport Administrators.

Any collision which results in a fatality, personal injury or total property damage of \$2,000 or more must be reported to the police.
